- A. Village Website - a letter has been received from the village hall committee following their meeting, the contents of which were read and noted
Discussion took place regarding the upgrade and the Parish Council studied a revised cost from an alternative provider of £400 for the initial work with a monthly subscription to cover hosting and updates. Once set up, other parties will be asked to contribute should they wish to continue their use of the website

Resolved Topcliffe Parish Council agreed unanimously that they wish to proceed with the upgrade Once complete, they will invite the Village Hall Committee to participate at an agreed cost

- B. Playing Field Lease - the Parish Council is bound by the terms of the lease to maintain a boundary and there is no right of residents to put an access from private properties into this field as it contravenes the lease.

Resolved Clerk to request the the residents remove/close up and access to the playing field from private properties under the condition of the lease
